When

What do you need to do?

- You need to have a genuine interest in baking (but you do not need any experience).
- Be able to follow a recipe,
- Follow food hygiene rules,
- Travel to Mycenae House
- Commit to come along to every session on Thursday for 10 weeks
- Arrive on time

What will you get?

- You will learn some baking skills and gain experience for your CV.
- It will be autism-friendly, run by 2 people who understand autism.
- It will be relaxed and enjoyable.
- You will learn to work with others and meet new people.
- Travel and lunch expenses paid.
